

Mountaineering, rock climbing, and leisure stereoscopic photographs were among the favorite hobbies of Eötvös, a pioneer of high precision geodetical physics, and a founding father of geophysics. He spent most of his summers in Felsőlendke in the Carpathian Basin, in the Carpathians. With his daughters he made the first ascent of several peaks and passes routes in that region. One of the peaks (Cima Ciocanu, 2675 m) in the Carpathians was named after him. Even at the age of 60, shortly before his death, he climbed some of the highest peaks of the Tatra mountains.




