

### The Eötvös 100 quiz arrived to the finale

In the framework of the Roland Eötvös Memorial Year ([www.eotvos100.hu](http://www.eotvos100.hu)), 224 teams (each of four members, high school students) applied for the Eötvös 100 literacy quiz. All five rounds of the digital pre-selection (started in and ended a few days ago) were completed by 181 teams. The best 14 teams forming the field of the finals are as follows.
